SCHOOL PLANNER:-

To ensure smooth coordination of school activities, we encourage parents to keep the planner handy and refer to it regularly. The planner will be distributed during the PTM for your convenience.

SCHOOL DIARY:-

The school diary is a vital communication link between the school, students and parents. It records academic progress, attendance, announcements and feedback. Parents must ensure their child carries the diary daily and check it regularly for updates on attendance, uniform, late arrivals, leave, homework or other concerns. To confirm receipt of information, parents are required to sign in the designated column. Your cooperation will ensure smooth communication and support your child's progress.

STUDENT FOLDER:-

Each student will receive a Student Folder, which will contain important documents such as the school planner, diary, syllabus, monogram and belt. Parents are kindly requested to collect this folder from the class teacher, on the result declaration day during the PTM. Verify its contents and ensure its safe use throughout the academic year. This folder will serve as a secure space for storing worksheets, mark sheets and other essential documents, helping keep students organized.

NOTE: All fees (tuition, activity, transport, etc.) must be paid quarterly in advance (April, July, October & January) by the 15th of the first month of each quarter. A late fee of ₹200 per month will be charged, if payment is delayed beyond this date. If fees remain unpaid for one quarter, the school reserves the right to strike off the student's name. If unpaid for two consecutive quarters, the Transfer Certificate (TC) will be sent to the parents via post after prior intimation.

❖ **CASHLESS TRANSACTION FACILITY:-**

All fees (tuition, activity & bus) must be deposited online through SBI Collect. No other payment modes will be accepted. In extreme cases, payments may be made via bank draft in favour of the school or in cash.

❖ **SCHOOL TRANSPORT:-**

The school is committed to providing safe and reliable transportation for students. Our buses are equipped with GPS tracking, first-aid kits, speed governors, CCTV cameras, and fire extinguishers. Parents are encouraged to avail of this facility for their child's safety. Bus fare is reasonable despite the school incurring losses on transport operations.

❖ **RULES FOR BUS USERS:**

- *The institution charges a bus fee for 10 months (excluding May & June).*
- *Once the bus facility is approved, it cannot be withdrawn under any circumstances during that academic session.*
- *The bus fare must be paid in advance every quarter along with school fees.*
- *Full month's fee is payable even if the bus is used for a single day in that month.*
- *If a student wishes to avail of bus service in the middle of the session, they will be required to pay the full 10 months bus fee.*
- *Bus stoppages and routes are fixed and cannot be altered for individual convenience.*
- *If parents change their address after admission, the school will make changes in the bus routes or stoppages as per convenience of the school. It will not be a binding on the school to provide bus facility on change of address of the student.*
- *Please ensure that your child arrives at the designated bus stop on time to avoid delays in the bus schedule. Being punctual helps maintain the efficiency of the buses and ensures timely arrival at school.*
- *Encourage your child to show respect and gratitude towards the bus drivers and helping staff. They play a vital role in ensuring the safety and comfort of the students during transportation.*
- *Eating, drinking, shouting, throwing objects, bullying or engaging in any other disruptive behaviour is not permitted in the bus. Such actions can endanger the safety of other students/staff due to distraction of the driver.*


❖ HOMEWORK POLICY:-


